INSTRUCTIONS FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Abstract should be computer typed as MS Word document in A4 size. Times New Roman, Font Size 12 and should be submitted as per the following format.

Preferred presentation type: Oral or Poster

Title: Should be in bold with first letter of each word in capital.

Author's name/s and Affiliation: Should be in capital letters, name of presenting author being underlined.

Author's name/s should be followed by their institution affiliation and the e-mail address of the presenting author.

Contents: Should include the aim of the study materials, methods, results, conclusion and key words. The abstract should not exceed 250 words. References, Tables, and graphs must not be included in the abstract.

The abstracts should be emailed to cpbhaisora33@gmail.com, icfmt13@gmail.com. The dead line for abstract submission is 15th August 2013.

Oral Presentation: Only power point presentation will be authorized at all congress sessions. The time limit for oral presentation will be 6 minutes: followed by a discussion for 2 minutes.

Poster session: Authors will provide a poster for display at the conference, the size of which should not exceed 4X3 feet.

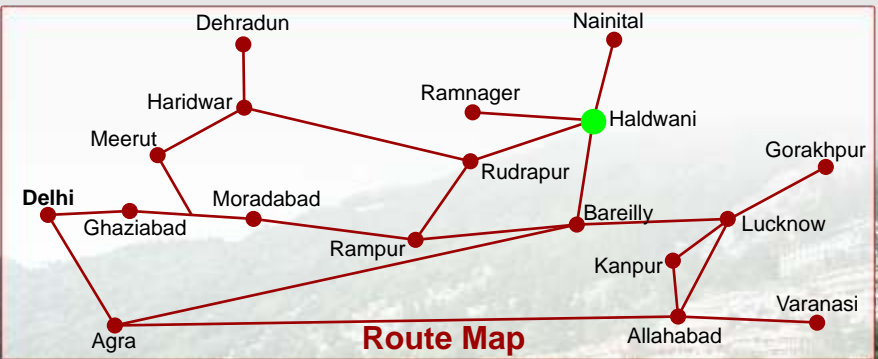
